COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS

Students going into 7th or 8th grade next year are eligible to take College Credit Plus (CCP) classes. It is mandatory for families to view the virtual presentation available on the high school counseling website at <https://www.usevs.org/o/ushs/page/college-credit-plus-ccp> by February 1, 2025, if your child is interested in taking CCP courses next year. In addition, the digital Letter of Intent must be submitted by April 1, 2025. The virtual presentation is required to be viewed EVERY year even if your child is already enrolled in CCP classes.
