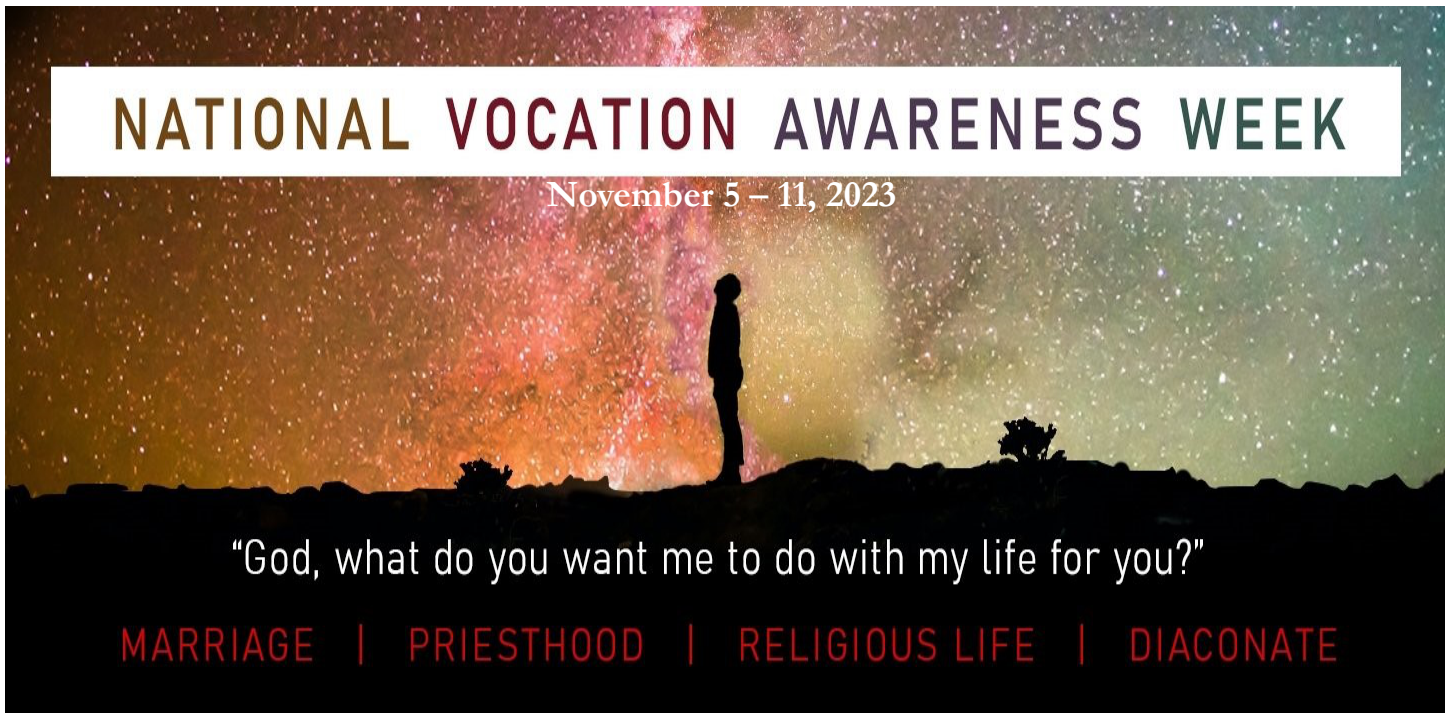
Eucharistic Adoration

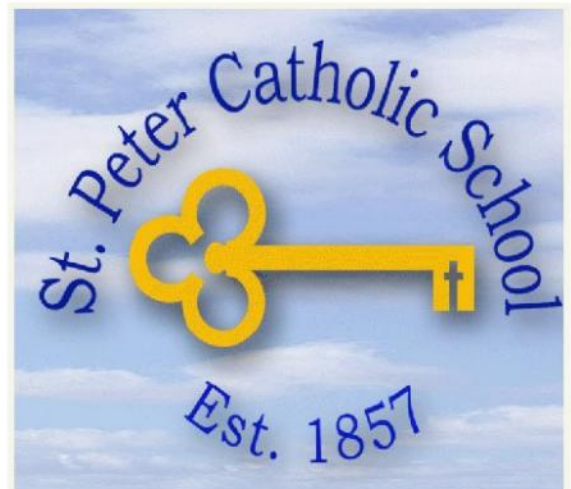

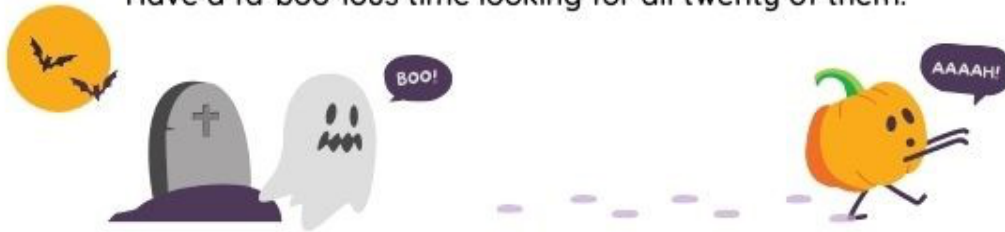
Congratulations to our Lady Colts:
