



PASCHAL TRIDUUM 2019

Transfiguration of the Lord Parish



HOLY THURSDAY - April 18

7:00 PM Mass of the Lord's Supper

(Church at Upper)

- *Oils received from the Bishop at the Chrism Mass are carried in procession during this Liturgy.*
- *We gather as a community of believers to begin our celebration of the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection.*
- *In keeping with the ancient mandate, feet are washed this night.*
- *At the conclusion of Mass, the Eucharist is transferred in solemn procession to the Resurrection Chapel where the Eucharist will be reposed.*

8:30 PM - 10:00 PM Adoration of the Eucharist

(Resurrection Chapel)

- *Just as Jesus invited Peter, James, and John to pray with Him on the night before His death in the Garden of Gethsemane, so too, do we watch and pray on this night.*
- *"Make a visit" with your family, friends, or on your own this night.*
- *After Mass, the church is bare. Not even the Eucharist remains.*

GOOD FRIDAY - April 19

3:00 PM

(Chapel at Kirby)

- *Stations of the Cross: "We remember that Jesus took up his cross and carried it up the hill of Calvary to Golgotha, where he was crucified for our sins."*

7:00 PM Liturgy of the Lord's Passion and Death

(Church at Upper)

- *On this day of fast and abstinence we recall solemnly the Lord's acceptance of the cross. We do so after the hour when Christ suffered and died. The Passion from St. John's Gospel is read. The Cross is venerated, and there is the reception of Holy Communion which was reserved from the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Thursday night.*
- *The cross remains in the church for prayer and devotion during the remainder of the evening.*

HOLY SATURDAY - April 20

9:00 PM Solemn Easter Vigil

(Church at Upper)

- *After nightfall we gather outside around the new fire (weather permitting). Christ, our Paschal Light, leads us into the darkened, lifeless church. Slowly his light is shared through our common baptism. The church begins to glow and live once again. We sing our Easter praises!*
- *After hearing portions of our Salvation History in the Liturgy of the Word, we experience the baptism of our catechumens and the profession of faith of our candidates before they receive the oil of Confirmation.*
- *We renew our own Baptism promises.*
- *Our vigil is made complete with the Eucharist.*
- *Our newly-initiated members of the church are welcomed after months of preparation.*
